Membership Presentation: Executive Director said this afternoon the Fund Attorney, Underwriting Manager and Environmental Engineer will be presenting EJIF services to the Atlantic JIF for possible membership. This is the third time the EJIF has made a presentation to the Atlantic JIF. Fund Attorney said they have worked on a very good proposal and presentation. Executive Director then played a recorded song to the tune of 'The Times They are a Changin' with custom lyrics about the upcoming presentation. The song was performed by Eric Harrison, a panel attorney for the JIF and was much appreciated by everyone.

UNDERWRITING MANAGERS:

Underwriting Manager said they are currently negotiating rates with the excess carrier and expect to come in at or under budget. Their office reviews the inspection scores and in the event of a failing score, his office will reach out to Risk Managers and offer assistance to members. Some

of the deductions seen in the lower scores this year are related to the changes in storm water permits.

Underwriting Manager said members received a memo from the Fund Attorney last month via email referencing the class action suit for PFAS exposure and members should review that memo for any steps they might want to take.

ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEER:

Environmental Engineer said the requirements for storm water permits have had more impact on the municipalities and hence on their inspection scores. There are many changes for both Tier A and B to meet the standards. His team is available and will help members come into compliance. They can help with such tasks as mapping infrastructure, and he encourages members to contact his office. Also members should apply for the grant if they have not done so.
