NJDEP Deadlines Fast Approaching

FEBRUARY 2012

The deadline for completing Receptor Evaluations (March 1, 2012) and retaining a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) (May 7, 2012) on any contaminated site in New Jersey is fast approaching. If your property has a NJDEP case number, a PI number, or has a confirmed discharge, these deadlines are applicable to your site. Failure to comply with the deadlines may result in your project remaining with the NJDEP, potentially being audited and fined.

Birdsall Services Group (BSG) personnel are trained and available to assist you in complying with these very important deadlines.

Additionally, please be aware that the NJDEP is devel-

oping a Remedial Priority Scoring (RPS) system pursuant to N.J.S.A.58:10-23.16, as amended in section 39 of P.L.2009, c.60 (Site Remediation Reform Act). The system has been developed to measure each site's relative risk to human and ecological health. The system will be enhanced as new data, improved logic and additional capabilities become available.

The NJDEP is currently mailing Responsible Parties (RPs) regarding their particular site's ranking and instructions on how to review and revise their ranking, with submittal of justification.

BSG is available to provide assistance if your facility needs help evaluating and addressing its RPS scoring.
