**EJIF DIVIDEND** - Mr. Kickham informed the Board that the request for approval of the EJIF's \$500,000 dividend was filed with the State on October 14, 2015. The fund office awaits their approval.

**NEXT MEETING -** Mr. Kickham informed the Board that the next meeting of the EJIF is scheduled for November 18, 2015 at the Sheraton Hotel, across from the AC convention center at 12 noon.

#### **ATTORNEY:**

Mr. Semrau indicated that he did not have a report for open session.

#### **UNDERWRITING MANAGERS:**

Mr. Avalone reported that the new policy form is currently under review by the excess carrier. He advised that a Coverage Committee meeting will be scheduled to review and recommend the final revised policy form to the Executive Board at the November meeting.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING:**

Mr. Erickson reported that September and October have been quiet on the regulatory front as Trenton continues to be at a standstill.

Mr. Erickson also reported that First Environment is in the process of wrapping up their member inspections for the 2015 fund year. He indicated that several of the underground piping systems with aboveground storage tanks have been removed from their database.

#### **ACTUARY**

Mr. Kullman reported that AON has completed their September  $30^{th}$  IBNR analysis. He noted that there has not been a lot of loss activity between June  $30^{th}$  and September  $30^{th}$  which resulted in a slight reduction to the ultimate cost estimates.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Commissioner Rheinhardt advised that representatives from the MEL Investment Committee interviewed Investors Bank (banking), Wilmington Trust (asset management); TD Bank

(banking & asset management) and Wells Fargo (banking & asset management) on October 14<sup>th</sup> for the positions of Banking Services and Asset Manager for the E-JIF, RCF, and MEL. The results were reviewed with the MEL Investment Committee on October 21, 2015. Commissioner Rheinhardt said awarding the banking contract to Investors Bank and the asset manager contract to Wilmington Trust represented the most cost effective program. He recommended beginning the transition process right away so that the accounts are in place at the start of the 2016 fund year. Mr. Kickham suggested authorizing the Treasurer to begin transferring the accounts during the current meeting and adopting a resolution appointing Investors Bank and Wilmington Trust during the November meeting. The Board was in agreement with the suggestion.
