EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR/ADMINISTRATOR:

2019 PROPOSED BUDGET – Mr. Sacco reported that during the September Executive Committee meeting, the Fund introduced a budget for Fund year 2019. He advised that in accordance with the regulations, the budget has been advertised in the Fund's official newspaper and sent to each member JIF. Mr. Sacco noted the Public Hearing for the budget will be held at this meeting and referred to the budget, as introduced, enclosed within the agenda.

EJIF DIVIDEND – Mr. Sacco informed the Board that the request for approval of the EJIF's \$1,250,000 dividend has been filed with the State for approval.

NEXT MEETING- Mr. Sacco said the next meeting of the EJIF is scheduled for November 14, 2018 at the Sheraton Hotel, across from the AC convention center at 12 noon.

FINANCIAL FAST TRACK – Mr. Sacco referred to the June 30th Financial Fast Track enclosed within the agenda booklet. He informed the Committee that as of June 30th the Fund is up \$952,724 for the year for a total statutory surplus of \$20.7 million. Mr. Sacco noted that the 2018 dividend has not been applied to the Financial Fast Track.

ATTORNEY:

Mr. Semrau advised that discussions regarding the Claims and matter involving professional services and contract negotiations will take place during Closed Session.

UNDERWRITING MANAGERS:

Mr. Casagrande reported that a coverage meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 14, 2018, just prior to the Regular EJIF Meeting at 12:00 PM on that date. He advised the coverage issues to be discussed are the proposed \$250,000 Sublimit for Pollution Damage as a result of a cyber event and an appropriate endorsement to the EJIF Tank Policy for those members that require DPCC Coverage (Discharge Prevention, Containment and Countermeasure) by virtue of their fitting the definition of a "Major Facility."

Mr. Casagrande advised that the EJIF Engineers have recently completed six (6) educational seminars for the EJIF Membership. The Seminar is titled "Complying with Changing Regulations" and provided valuable information concerning the new Stormwater Permit Rules and new Underground Storage Tank Rules.

Mr. Casagrande reported that the general liability for the 38 Lagoon Drive has been renewed on 09/27/2018 and remains in force. After the two initial offers that were relatively low, no additional activity to date on the sale of this property.

Lastly, Mr. Casagrande informed the Board that the marketing process for the 2019 EJIF Excess Coverage is ongoing as the EJIF Underwriters have met with the incumbent excess carrier, Ironshore Insurance Company and other potential carriers.

ACTUARY:

Mr. Kullman advised he had nothing to report for the month.

ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING:

Mr. Erickson informed the Board that the audit process is near conclusion. He informed the Board that two trends he is seeing are fewer USTs and fewer ASTs with underground piping.

Mr. Mee informed the Board that PS&S has completed their 2018 inspections and has submitted the database to Perma. He also informed the Board that the seminar series has been completed. He added that the series received over 150 RSVPs and he received positive feedback.
